President's Report

- The AWTRS travel award recipients were announced as Chris Turner and Katie Sizeland.
- The AWTRS conference attendance awards were given to Hanif Haidari (UniSA), Savannah Aticheson (QUT), Zalitha Pieterse (Curtin U), Ziyu Wang (USyd) and Zoe West (QUT).
- BF gave a summary of the 2020 Pan Pacific Connective tissue symposium which had 122 attendees and was held in conjunction with the Matrix Biology Society of Australia and New Zealand
- The major sponsors of the 2020 Pan Pacific Symposium were: Phoenix Eagle, University of Melbourne, Future Industries Institute, Lonza and PeproTech.

Treasurer's Report

- The society is currently financially solvent
- Profit was made from memberships and the 2019 Symposium.
- Expenditures included: Small Talk Events, AWTRS website grants and travel awards.
- The report was seconded by RM and BF

Secretary's Report

- SM announced that membership started with 57 members and had risen to 62 financial members.
- 32 memberships are due to expire on 31.12.2020.
- The report was seconded by BF and RM.

ECR report

- XS reported that the AWTRS along with the Matrix Biology Society of Australia and New Zealand applied for the Theo Murphy Initiative EMCR Program but only a small amount of the money was available due to Covid-19.
- This money was used to organise the Techniques Toolbox seminar, immediately after the AGM, and a trivia night.
- The AWTRS supported 5 conference support awards for ECRs.
- XS also announced that there would also now be two AWTRS ECR awards in the form of a Young Investigator award (for members awarded their PhD within 2 years of application) and a EMCR award (for members awarded their PhD within 3-10 year of application).
XS also mentioned the AWTRS newsletter and twitter account.
- This report was seconded by PK and RM.
