#### Financial report for July 2022 to June 2023

• Closing balance was \$43,821.45, which was lower than 2021-2022 (\$48,421.92).

#### Breakdown of income:

• \$4469.02 with membership income slightly reduced and a \$1499.79 loss for the 2022 conference.

#### Breakdown of expenditure:

• \$8862.69 with consistent costs for the small talk membership portal and website hosting, but a substantial increase in Travel/EMCR awards.

#### Summary:

• Finances are in good shape, but income is down, increasing the need to raise more funds to maintain our current balance, to support expenditure on our critical awards and travel grants.
